**Secretary's Report:** A motion was made, seconded and approved by the Board members in attendance to accept the Secretary's reports from December 3 and December 7, 2012.

**Treasurer's Report:** It was reported that the Club has \$2,549 in the bank, which does not include \$200 in the cash box and \$390 for SOS cards. Treasurer Dean Hatcher indicated it is time to pay our \$50 dues to ASCS. Also, the check for \$500 written in December for Mooseheart has not cleared the bank. A motion was made, seconded and approved by Board members in attendance to wait until the January 27 dance to address this if the check has still not cleared the bank.

**Old Business:** The first dance of 2012 will be on January 13 at the VFW with DJ Bill Ruth. Members are asked to bring Soups and Stews.

**New Business:** The Re-Up/Join-Up dance will be held on January 27 at the Moose Lodge with DJ "Fessa" John Hook. The Dance will begin at 6pm and dinner will be provided by the Club.

The Valentine dance will be held on February 10 at the VFW with DJ Terry McPhail. Members are asked to bring "Heart Healthy" dishes. Three lucky women in the Club will win a dozen roses each.

**Open Discussion:** The Food Drive to benefit the Brunswick County Food Bank will be conducted at the February 24 dance at the Moose Lodge.
